Teddy Bear, Teddy Bear, say good night

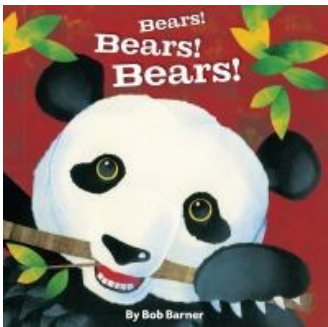

# Shadow Drawing

Shadow Drawing is best done outside on a nice sunny day.

So, grab your hat and put on some sunscreen.

You will need :

- \* Some paper
- \* A pencil
- \* Something to cast a shadow  
*maybe a small teddy, a toy, a rock, a shoe*

1) Put the paper on a flat sunny spot

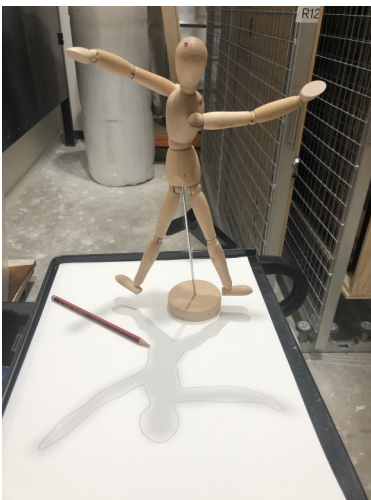
2) Place your teddy on the edge of the paper so you can see it's shadow

3) Using your pencil, trace around the shadow

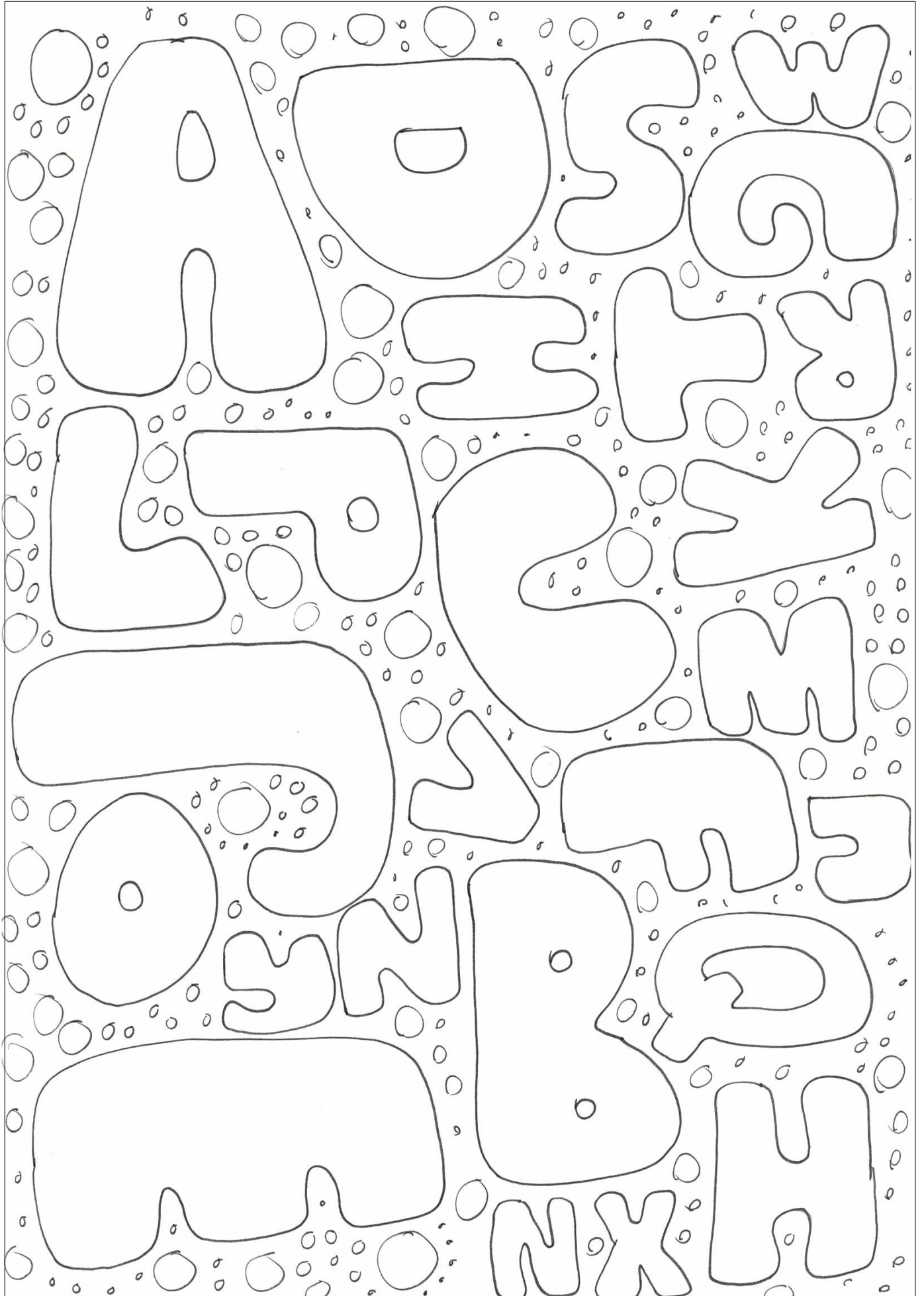
*(depending on how bright the sun is, will depend how dark your shadow is)*

4) Move your teddy away and To-Do you've made a drawing of the teddy's shadow.
