Something to MAKE

A NEWSPAPER FACE

These newspaper sculptures titled 'Ecological Invasion' are by Hannah Kohler from Wollongong High School of the Performing Arts. They are on exhibition at Goulburn Regional Art Gallery as part of the ARTEXPRESS 2020 exhibition.



We are going to make a rolled or scrunched up paper face. It's nearly Fathers Day so maybe you could make dad or your grandad or another important man in your life.



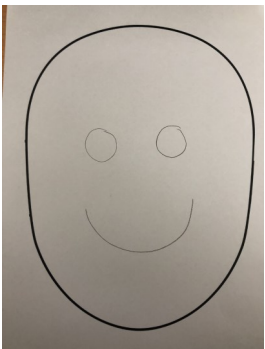
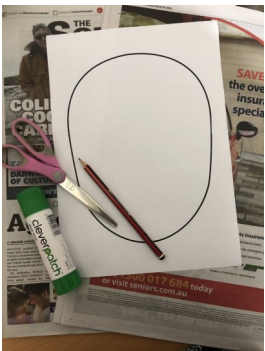

You will need:

* An old newspaper, magazine or any scrap paper

* Face template

* Glue



1) Draw eyes and mouth on your face template as a guide.

2) Look at how Hannah has turned newspaper into a rolled strip. Roll some newspaper strips, put a little glue at the end to stop it unravelling or scrunch up paper into small balls.

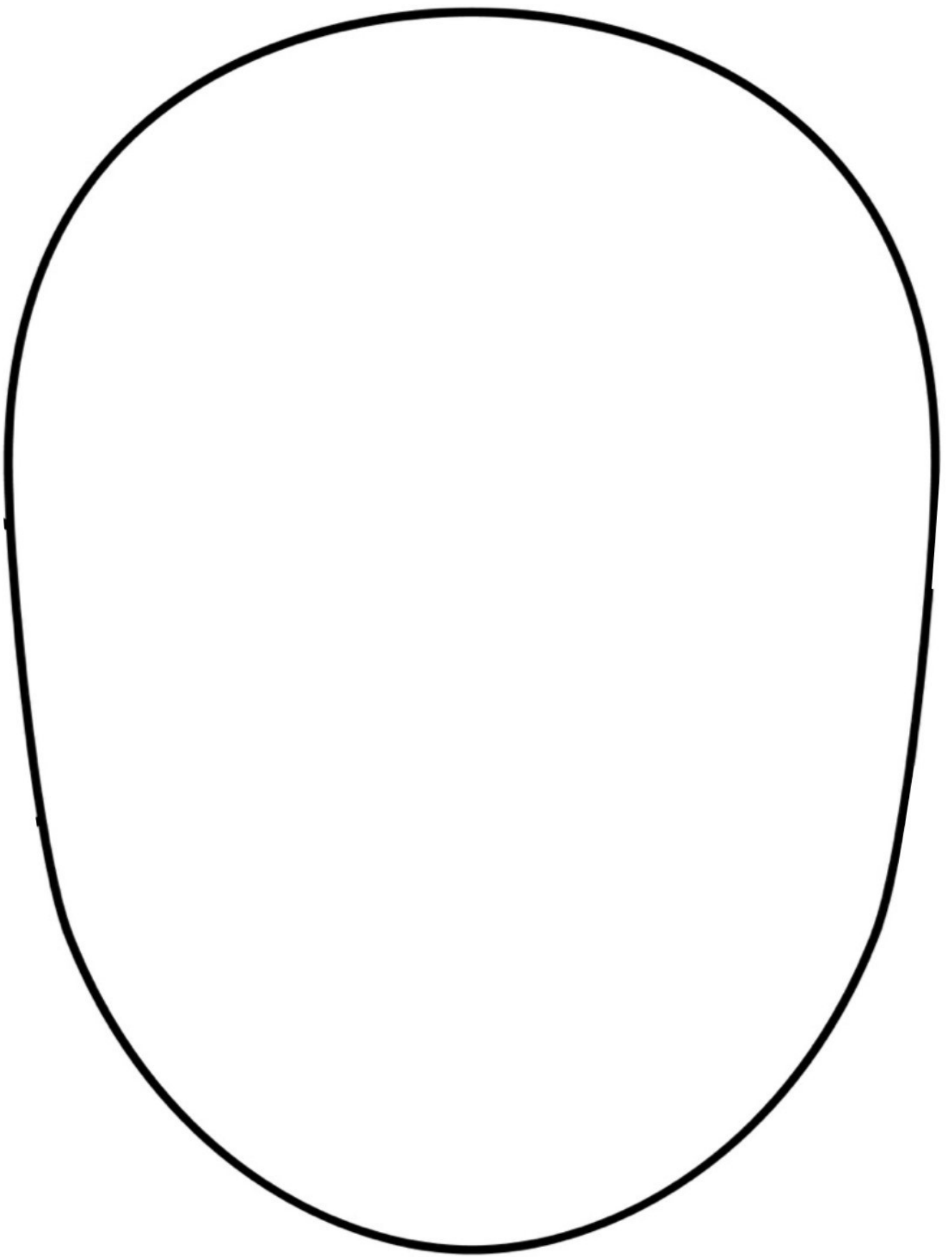
3) Glue your paper on the face template to create your face.

4) Glue in different directions to make lines for mouth and nose, in circles to make eyes.

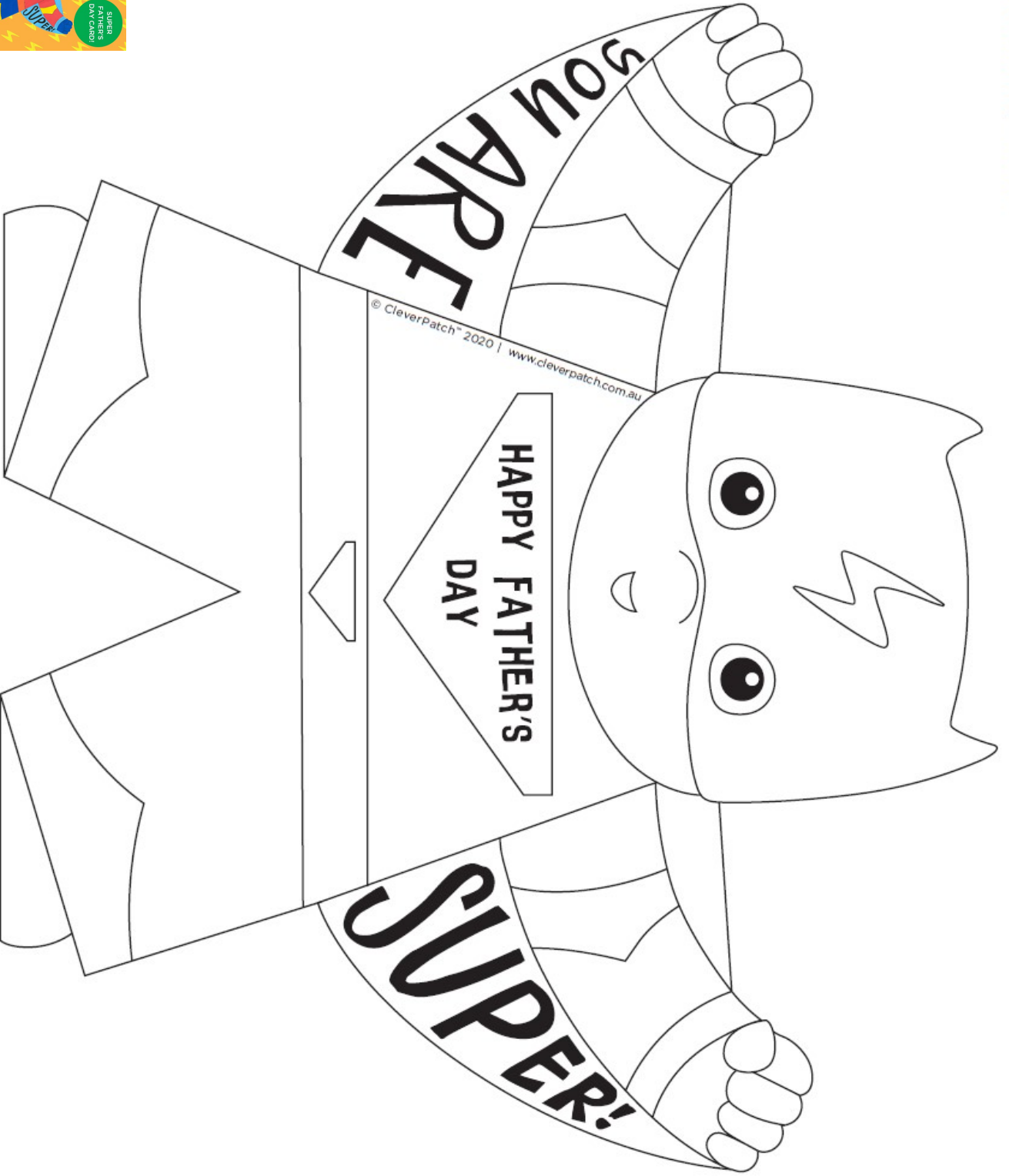
5) Look at how Hannah used feathers and newspaper to make the Lyrebirds tail.

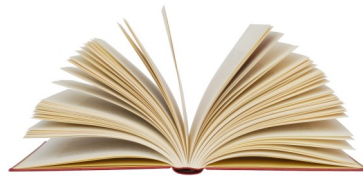

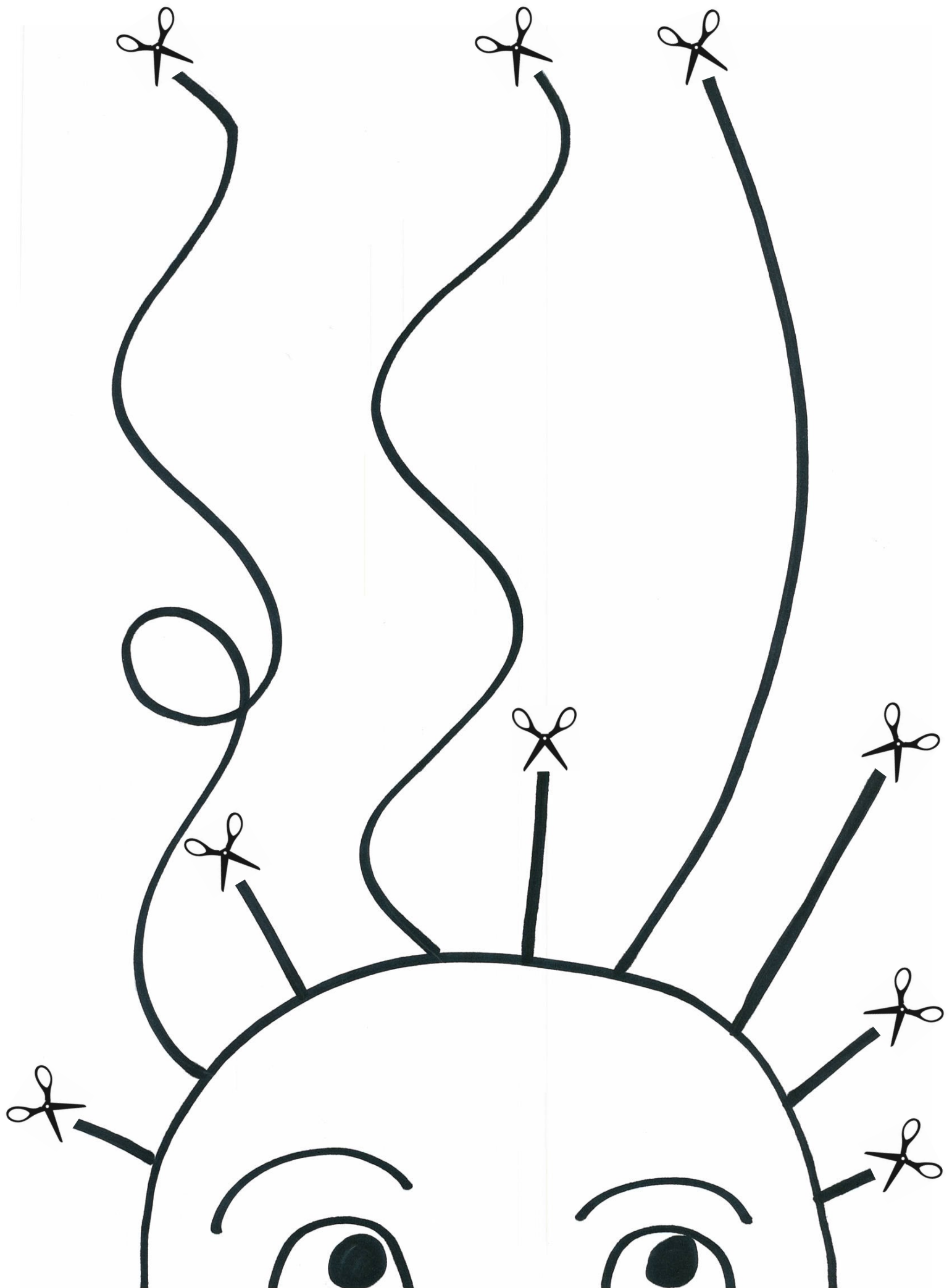

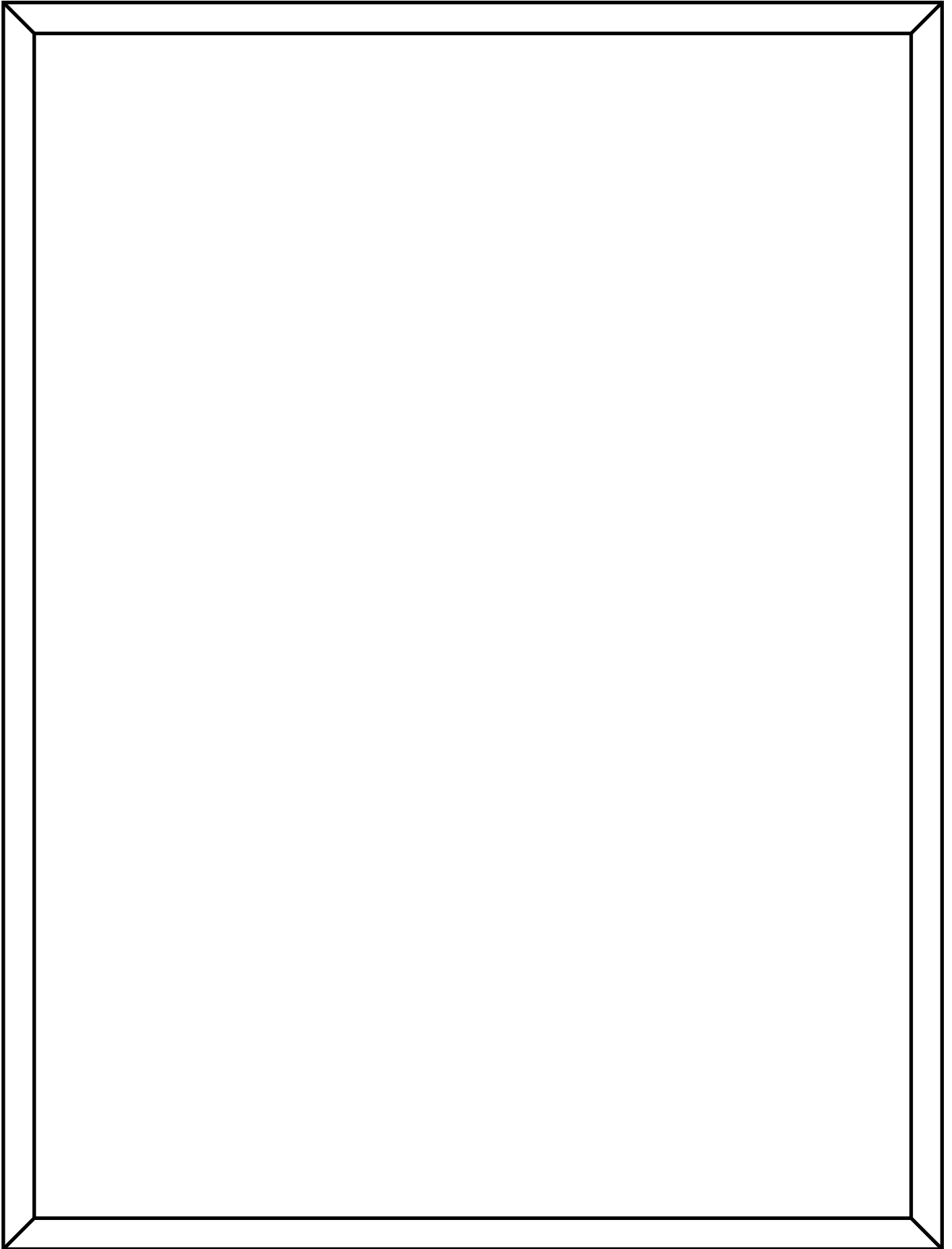
